Tinley Park is on I-80 located 27 miles southwest of Chicago. This would allow the Midwest Region of NCCC to showcase our Region and all the things there are to do around the Chicago and Midwest area. The Convention would include the following:

Saturday registration, tech, and National Awards Party in the evening.

Sunday morning an indoor Concours held at the Convention Center.

Sunday afternoon a People's Choice car show held in the downtown Tinley Park

Monday morning a Rallye on old Route 66 to start and finish at The Autobahn.

Monday a Practice Track Day on the full 3.56 mile / 21 turn road course held at The Autobahn Road Course in Joliet, Illinois. On Monday there will be an opportunity to run your car at competitive speeds for a fee, a free lapping experience with a passenger for all convention attendees, Go-Karts on the Low Speed Track, dinner and entertainment. The Autobahn is approximately 22 miles west of the Tinley Park.

Tuesday and Wednesday a non-driving Funkhana at the Tinley Park Convention Center

Thursday is Record Drags, Bracket Drags and a Test and Tune time held at Route 66 Raceway in Joliet, 21 miles west of Tinley Park.

Friday has a Golf Tournament at Odyssey Country Club, 1 mile from Convention Center.

Daily bus tours to unlimited local attractions (Chicago, Museums, Shopping, Zoos, The Bean, Navy Pier, Magnificent Mile, White Sox and Chicago Cubs all within 1 hour)

Friday and Saturday Bloomington Gold Corvette Show ~ June 23 -25, 2011 48 miles from Tinley Park Convention Center

Saturday through Friday Great Parties every night..... all week.

Evening Children's Program during convention parties.
