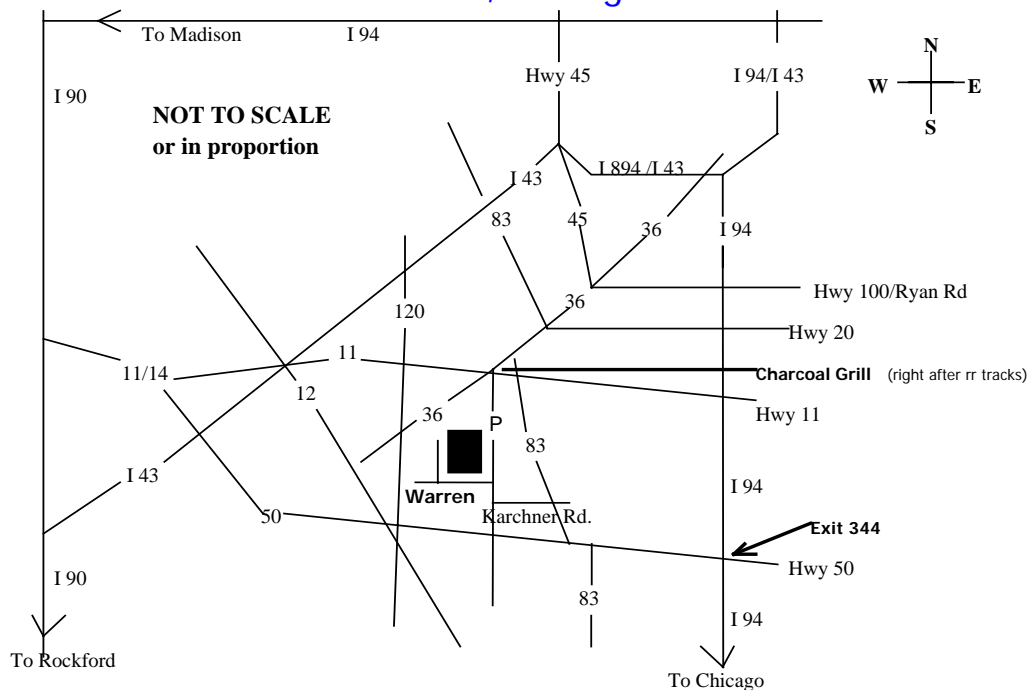

## MGA RESEARCH CORP. ~ 5000 Warren Rd., Burlington WI

**From Highway 36:** go through Burlington to Hwy P (Hwy P is McHenry St. in the city of Burlington; you will see the street sign before you see the highway sign. St Mary's, a huge church, is about a block after you turn) - go south approx. 4.5 miles to Warren Rd. - turn right on Warren; go approx. .5 mile and turn north on Walberg Rd. - follow signs. Gate for skid pad is approx. .5 mile after you turn on Walberg

**From Highway 50:** go to Hwy P; go north on Hwy P approx. 2.5 miles to Warren Rd. - turn left on Warren and go approx. .5 mile and turn north on Walberg Rd. - follow signs. Gate for skid pad is approx. .5 mile after you turn on Walberg

**From other areas:** please refer to an up-to-date Wisconsin map for your best route to Hwy 11, Hwy 50 or Hwy 36 and then follow the above instructions.



## EVENT SITE INFORMATION

MGA Research in Burlington, Wisconsin is a 12-acre skid pad with plenty of run-off. The Speed Event course will be set just under one mile in length with limited pylons.

### \*\*\*SITE RESTRICTIONS ~ please read carefully.\*\*\*

- ✓ It is MANDATORY that EVERYONE stays within the designated areas we are allowed to use (i.e., only the skid pad area as well as the short road from the gate to the skid pad). ANYONE leaving these areas will be disqualified & ejected from the events. Due to the sensitive nature of this business site, the host clubs have no other option but to eject someone who has left the immediate event area. The only area that is not restricted is the short road from the gate to the skid pad, the skid pad itself and the semi-circular road with its grassy area.
- ✓ No alcohol or beer is allowed anywhere on the grounds.
- ✓ Pets are not allowed anywhere on the grounds including inside vehicles.
- ✓ Tow vehicles & trailers cannot park on the edge of the skid pad. Park in grassy area only.
- ✓ No grills or camping allowed. "Porta potties" are available. Provide own shade, lawn chairs, sunscreen & water.
