Lodging Information:

Eastern Illinois University has track day on Friday May 22nd taking most of the hotels rooms in the area. Windy City Corvettes has reserved a block of rooms for Friday May 22nd in Arcola at the Comfort Inn. Call 217 268-4000 for the \$99 rate. Arcola is a fifteen minute drive from the airport. Windy City Corvettes also has a block of rooms for Saturday at the Baymont Inn in Mattoon. Call 217 234-2420 for the \$74 rate.

Driving from the North? The Quarters in Rantoul (1 hour from Mattoon) is an option for Friday. Call 217-893-1234

Coles County airport is located about 1 mile east on Illinois Route 16 from I-57. Turn right at airport road after passing the BP Gas Station. Keep to your right to the parking area. The award winning Airport Steakhouse is in the terminal building and it will be open for breakfast, lunch and dinner. We will be racing on a concrete parking pad and adjacent asphalt taxiway that is well maintained – No loose concrete or tar strips and we will be isolated from aviation activity.

Cody's is a Western Steakhouse style restaurant with peanut shells on the floor, beverages, and good food. Just west of I-57, turn right at the Marathon Gas Station and right again at the stop sign. The Baymont Inn is within walking distance.
