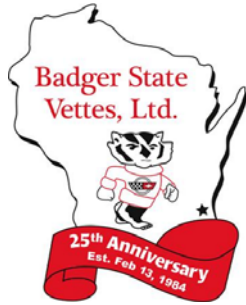

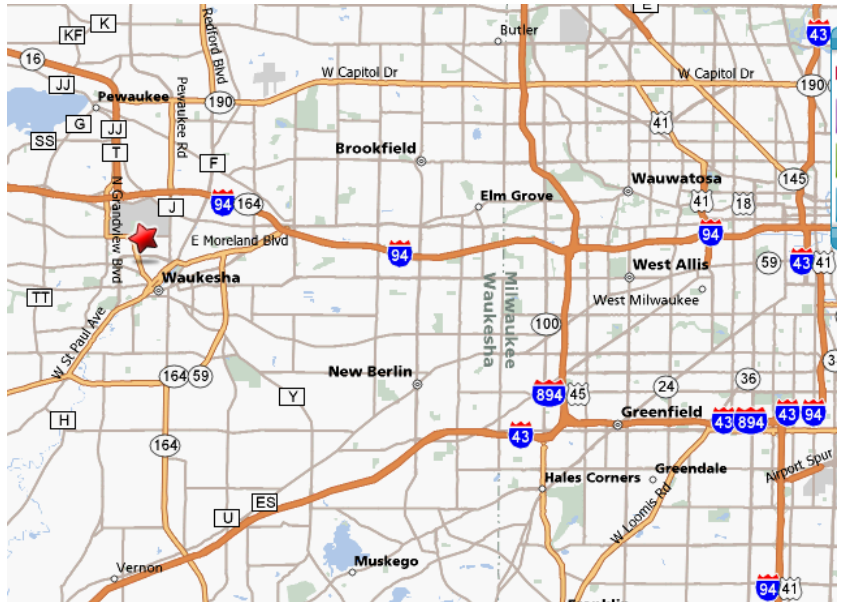

From the East (Milwaukee WI): Take I-94 west to Exit 294 (Hwy. J/164) approx. 9 miles west of the I-894/I-94/Hwy. 45 intersection. Take Exit 294 left (south) onto Hwy. J (Pewaukee Rd). Go to Northview Rd and turn right (west) and go to the entrance of the Waukesha County Expo Center.



From the West (Madison): Take I-94 east to Exit 293 (Hwy.T). Take Exit 293, turn right (south) onto Hwy. T (N Grandview Blvd). Take Hwy T to Northview Rd. Turn left and go to the entrance of the Waukesha County Expo Center.

From the South (Chicago IL): Take I-94 north into Wisconsin; proceed on I-94 in Wisconsin to bypass I-894. Take I-894 west and then north to I-94. Take I-94 left (west towards Madison) approx. 9 miles. Take Exit 294 left (south) onto Hwy. J (Pewaukee Rd). Go to Northview Rd and turn right (west) and go to the entrance of the Waukesha County Expo Center.

From the Southwest (Rockford): Take I-43 northeast towards Milwaukee. Take I-894 north (towards Madison) to I-94. Take I-94 left (west towards Madison) approx. 9 miles. Take Exit 294 left (south) onto Hwy. J (Pewaukee Rd). Go to Northview Rd and turn right (west) and go to the entrance of the Waukesha County Expo Center.

From other areas: please refer to up-to-date maps for your best route to one of the above cities and then follow the instructions from that city.

Obvious things that move a car to Group-3 include: Non-stock cam, heads, throttle body/carb, intake manifold, brake rotors/calipers, non-DOT tires, Non-stock Blower or Turbo, etc.

**Coil-overs = RP **Weight reductions = RP **Up/backdate between Year Groups (exc C2/C3) = RPAF
