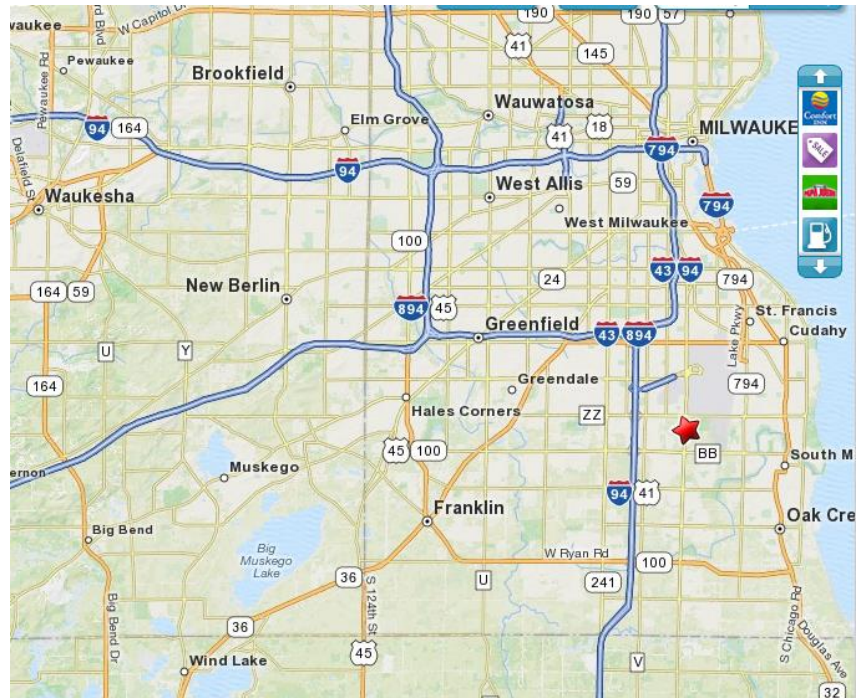
Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC), 6665 S. Howell Avenue, Oak Creek, WI

From the East and North (Milwaukee WI): Take I-94 south to College Ave. exit in Oak Creek, WI; take College Ave. east to S. Howell Ave.; take S. Howell Ave. south to MATC on the right.

From the West (Madison): Take I-94 east to I-894 south (Chicago); take I-894 south and then east on I-894/I-43 to I-94 south (Chicago); take I-94 south to College Ave. exit in Oak Creek, WI; take College Ave. east to S. Howell Ave.; take S. Howell Ave. south to MATC on the right.

From the South (Chicago IL): Take I-94 north into Wisconsin; proceed on I-94 in Wisconsin to the E. Rawson Ave. exit in Oak Creek, WI; take E. Rawson Ave. east to S. Howell Ave.; take S. Howell Ave. north to MATC on the left.

From the Southwest (Rockford): Take I-43 northeast towards Milwaukee.; take I-894/I-43 east (Chicago) to I-94 south (Chicago); take I-94 south to College Ave. exit in Oak Creek, WI; take College Ave. east to S. Howell Ave.; take S. Howell Ave. south to MATC on the right.



PLEASE NOTE: If you enter off Howell, the track is located behind the school. You can also enter MATC off College Ave (approx. 5th Street). There is no street sign but you will see a school Marquee.
