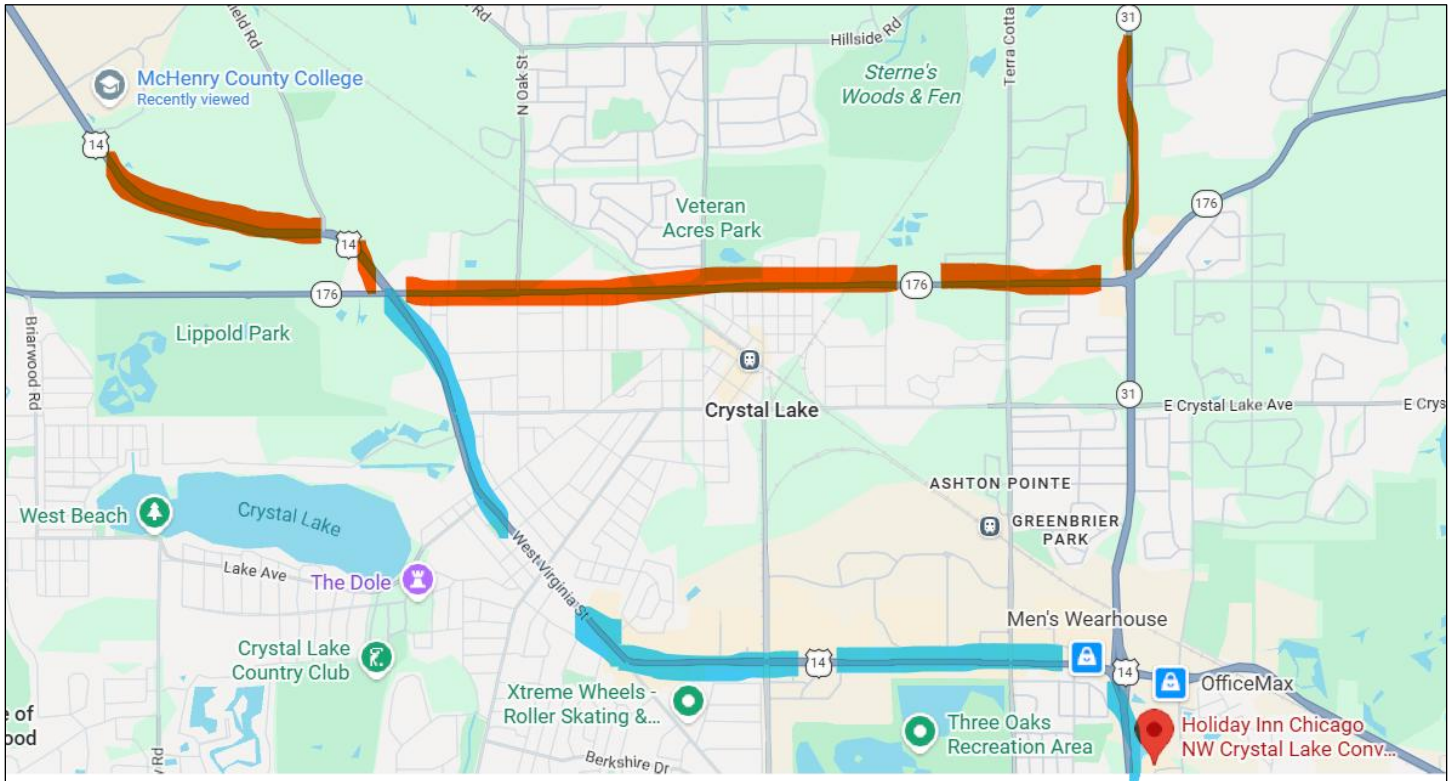

 \*\*Weight reductions = RP \*\*Up/backdate between Year Groups (exc C2/C3) = RPAF
