50 YEARS OF RACING - COLOR RUNS - SOCIAL EVENTS

Suburban Corvettes of Minnesota was in the preparation stages for a three-day event to celebrate our 50th Anniversary when COVID-19 put an end to the planning and the event. In 1970, Suburban Corvettes was founded by a group of Corvette enthusiasts interested in racing - especially drag racing. Existing Corvette clubs, at that time, did not offer racing events so the club was formed. Suburban held drag racing events at Minnesota Dragways and other racing related events at Brainerd International Raceway for over twenty-five years. The club also sponsored road rallies, car shows, funkhanas and held progressive themed dinners. While racing is not the main focus of the club today, it has been replaced with many social activities. The club is grateful to all those members who contribute their time and energy to hosting the numerous events held each year.

Suburban Corvettes has been hosting an annual Fall Color Run as its premier event for the past 39 years. This year would have been our 40th consecutive year but it also fell to COVID-19. The club is enthusiastic about the event for next year, which is scheduled for October 8, 9 & 10, 2021. The run is located in the LaCrosse, Wisconsin area and includes some of the best sports car roads in America plus nightly entertainment, food and drink and an exceptional Sunday brunch.
