



All roads and highway are smooth and well maintained. Should take about 2 Hours or so through some scenic areas. There is a shorter route that goes through more towns but takes longer. On the west edge of Wisconsin Dells, take I-90 East to Hwy 33 East. At Portage connect with Hwy 68 East. At Waupun turn left to Hwy 151 North. On the NE side of Fon du Lac turn right onto Hwy 23 East. At Plymouth, turn left onto Hwy 67 North. Road America is on the left just North of Plymouth

Everyone will make a left turn into Gate 6 to enter Road America.









Wisconsin Dells to Rock Falls Raceway

South from Eau Claire (I-94/Exit #65)
Take I-94 West to the 3rd Eau Claire Exit # 65 (WI 37/WI 85)

Exit onto Hwy 37 South and travel about 3 miles until you reach Hwy 85 Turn onto Hwy 85 and travel about 6 miles to Caryville.

Take the first left in Caryville onto 190th Avenue.

Travel about 1 mile and take a right onto 1000th Street.

Go up the hill (Rock Falls Raceway will be on your left). Turn left onto

170th Avenue and the entrance to the Raceway will be on your left. Turn left into the Racers Entry road and stop to register




