2.12 ASSIGNED SPEED EVENT NUMBERS

The RCD will administer a program allowing Midwest Region Members to request an Assigned Speed Event Number for their sole use during the competition year for Midwest Region speed events. Assigned numbers will not be issued to any other competitor. Checks will be payable to NCCC-Midwest Region. (11/10/2018)

2.12.1 PRIORITY

Members with assigned numbers from the previous year will have priority for that number during the Renewal period. The previous year's Men's and Ladies Regional Champions will be assigned 1 and 1L respectively; and their last assigned number will be reserved while they remain champions. (11/10/2018)

2.12.2 RENEWAL OF ASSIGNED NUMBERS

Applications will be sent to the RCD and postmarked no earlier than Jan. 1st and no later than Jan. 31st. Ten dollars (\$10) for each requested number will be enclosed with the application. The RCD will request that a list of renewed numbers be posted on the Midwest Region website. Numbers not renewed will be available. (11/10/2018)

2.12.3 APPLICATION FOR ASSIGNED NUMBER

Numbers 2 through 999 that are not assigned may be applied for by Midwest Region members. Applications will be sent to the RCD and postmarked no earlier than Feb. 15th and no later than Mar. 15th. Fifteen dollars (\$15) for each requested number will be enclosed with the application. (11/10/2018) (2/23/2019)

2.12.4 ASSIGNMENT ORDER

The RCD will assign new number requests in order of the postmark date. Requests with the same postmark will be resolved by random drawing.

2.12.5 CONFIRMATIONS

The RCD will e-mail confirmations of requested numbers at the end of the renewal period and update assigned numbers in the NCCC Membership database. (11/10/2018) (09/07/19)

2.12.6 ASSIGNED NUMBER LIST

The RCD will request that a list of assigned numbers be posted on the region website and will e-mail a copy of the assigned number list to each region Governor. (11/10/2018)

2.12.7 REQUESTING NUMBERS AT AN EVENT

Event registration is responsible for assigning numbers for the event(s) using the published list. Available numbers will be assigned in numerical order. Region members without an assigned number who wish to use a number other than the one given to them during Registration must pay ten dollars (\$10.00). The number is good for the weekend only. The ten dollars (\$10) to be sent to the MWR Treasurer by check made payable to NCCC-Midwest Region and made a part of the Assigned Number income for the year. (11/10/2018 and 9/11/2021)

2.12.8 NCCC CONVENTION REGISTRATION FOR ASSIGNED NUMBERS

Per the December 1998 sanction meeting, a deadline extension may be granted if an entrant desires to apply for a number assignment equal to his/her NCCC Convention registration number for the current year. The application must be postmarked no later than June 15 and must follow all the steps as outlined in the Speed Event Number Procedure. In addition, the applicant must provide the RCD with a copy of his/her Convention registration confirmation at the time of the application. (12/06/98)

2.12.9 MWR ASSIGNED SPEED EVENT NUMBERS FOR OUT OF REGION NCCC MEMBERS

After Midwest Region members have renewed their Assigned Speed Event numbers and after Midwest Region members have requested and been assigned new Assigned Speed Event numbers as outlined by the MWR RCD each year, Out of Region NCCC members will be given an opportunity to apply for a Midwest Region Speed Event number for their sole use during the competition year for Midwest Region speed events. The Out of Region cost would be \$15.00 enclosed with their application.

They would be able to apply for Renewal of their number each year only if their number has not been granted to a Midwest Region member during the annual Assigned Speed Event number process for MWR members. The Out of Region renewal cost would also be \$15.00 enclosed with their application. Their request would be postmarked no earlier than April 1st and no later than April 30th. (11/13/21)
