### **MWR Secretary Report– Jeanne Cassel**

June 6, 2020 Meeting Minutes were e-mailed to MWR officers and Governors on June 15, 2020. Motion made by Sandy Arnold, seconded by Dave Heinemann to approve minutes as mailed.

### **MWR-RMD– Sandy Arnold**

**Report from RMD –**

- **St Jude Event Update:** St. Jude Corvette Drive will not be driving to Memphis as in past years, due to the Corona virus; instead there will be an event, renamed “Kruzin for Kidz” this year. It will be held in the Peoria, IL area on Friday, August 21, 2020 from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Registration fee is \$50 per car. An Event Box will be provided to each car that registers, which will include a Drive shirt(s), an event guide, car decals and other St. Jude items.

Drive your Corvettes to the random stops that will be identified to pick up St. Jude items, random door prizes, offer up challenges or take photos.

Fundraising minimums will remain the same; \$1,000 for the Driver and \$500 for the passenger. That is a total of \$1,500.

This gives Sandy about 3 weeks for her work, and gives her time to get the information to Chris Reitz. Clubs should start renewals in October so all can be done for November 7<sup>th</sup>. Closer to September we should send a reminder to Governors.

### **MWR-RCD Report – Ray Bair**

**Report from RCD meeting:**

- Ray thanked all governors who came to/joined the meeting.
- Report from June 12 National RCD Conference: Only 8 RCDs were at the meeting. Bill Docherty didn’t want to make a formal decision on how people feel about suspending points for 2020 with so few governors there. Ray asked the MWR Governors present were asked what their thoughts were. All present agreed that the decision has to be fair for every region. There is a plan to meet July 1. **Update: On July 1 the RCDs voted to suspend national points for the 2020 season.**
- MW Region Event status – cancellations and possibilities were discussed. Future events discussed but so much is unknown. There are a lot of factors to consider in addition to safety, including but not limited to people/workers and participants as well as expenses. Preregistration may be vital – it can let clubs have an idea of how many will show and if not enough, the event can be cancelled. Considerable discussion took place but because of the unknowns nothing was finalized.
- Memorial Day Fundraiser status – cancelled – hope to reschedule
- October Region Fundraiser status – Rantoul is still hopeful

- John Hibbeler confirmed his event is canceled. John was thanked for offering his Central Illinois's date and locale to the region.
- **Update June 30, 2020: It is now mandatory that every club gathering or activity have everyone sign the standard waiver until the COVID threat has passed, even those activities which did not previously require waivers. This includes venue employees and vendors that are at the event. It is also important that any and every event follows all state and local regulations.**

#### **MWR-RE Report – Larry Pagliaro**

- Member passing's since the last Governors meeting. No information currently received about any members who have recently passed. Going forward, please check the club member's NCCC status. Only Active NCCC members are mentioned in Blue Bars due to space constraints.
- 2021 Officer Nominating Committee report – **Committee Members** –Tom Reitz did not submit an update.
- Bylaw Changes. 14 Bylaw Changes – mostly clean up issues - were presented by Deb Murphy, Nelda Mitchell and Barb Johnson. Dave Goebel submitted 1 change pertaining to his role. It is anticipated these will be discussed at the July 1 meeting and Larry will send the draft of the by-law changes for governor's review.
- Larry's proposed dates to meet again were discussed. Larry will ask officers to let him know what times work best for them for August 10<sup>th</sup> as we get closer to the date.
