

2022 NCCC Midwest Region Helmet Sticker Guidance

Revised March 1, 2022

- Helmet must meet the current NCCC Rule Book requirements. Note that Snell Foundation certification is required, either SA, SAH, M or EA. DOT certification is not sufficient without the Snell certification.
- Stickers may only be put on helmets that qualify for the whole Midwest Region season. Helmets that expire during the season cannot have a sticker.
- The presence of a sticker demonstrates an approved tech inspection and compliance for the full Midwest Region season.
- A helmet may be inspected any time during the year if there is any question of its compliance or condition.
- Any sticker that is not complete or peeling off requires an inspection and a new sticker.
- It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure their equipment is in working order and complies with the NCCC rulebook.
- Sticker should face the driver's window so it can be seen. Alternately, the sticker may be placed on the front of the helmet so it can be seen from either side.
- The Midwest Region RCD will hold the supply of helmet stickers, and they will be available to all Midwest Region Club Governors or a qualified designated representative who will apply them.

Process for Helmet Check NCCC Midwest Region 2022

Does the helmet have a Snell Foundation 2015 or Snell 2020 sticker? If it does, no need to check dates. Helmet is good for 2022. Apply Midwest Region 2022 sticker. (Snell 2020 helmets ~~will not be~~ were not available until October 1, 2020. Snell 2015 production ended March 31, 2021.)

Does the helmet have a Snell 2010 sticker? If it does, check the date of manufacture. Helmets made **after** December 31, 2012 are good for the 2022 Midwest Region season and get a sticker.

Snell 2010 helmets manufactured prior to December 31, 2012 can only be used until they are 10 years old, but do not get the sticker since they need to be checked at each event. For example, a Snell 2010 helmet manufactured on July 4, 2012 can only be used until July 4, 2022. It **does not** get a 2020-2022 sticker.
